SHOW RULES, PROCEDURES & REGULATIONS

This Show is held under licence from the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy (GCCF) and is open to all. All exhibitors must abide by the Rules of the GCCF and should read Section 4 of the Rules for Exhibits and Exhibitors. A copy of these Rules may be obtained from the GCCF, 5 King's Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgwater TA6 4AG. Ignorance of these Rules will not be accepted as an excuse of their breach.

REGISTRATIONS

Cats, Kittens and Neuters are eligible for the Show if registered with the GCCF. Unregistered Kittens and Neuters, with one or both parents who are unregistered, may be entered in the Non-Pedigree Section. Kittens under the age of 14 weeks may not be shown. To be effective for this Show all registrations and/or transfers must have reached the GCCF Office by at least 21 days before the Show. If the registration number is not to hand when completing the entry form, write RAF (registration applied for) or TAF (transfer applied for) in the appropriate column and advise the Show Manager in writing when the number is known. Write your first choice of name in the appropriate column and inform the Show Manager if the name should be changed.

Cats with unregistered parents but which are themselves registered (on June 1st 1971) and which were eligible for Challenge Certificates on that date, shall continue to be so and so shall their suitable progeny for three generations from October 20th 1971. THEREAFTER only cats with registered parents, grandparents and great-grandparents shall be eligible.

SHOW ENTRY

In order to exhibit at the Show, the exhibitor must complete the official Entry Form and subscribe to the declaration therein. Every exhibit must be identified on the official Entry Form exactly as recorded on the registration or transfer certificate relating to it. Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of their exhibit and entering them into the correct classes. Exhibits domiciled elsewhere will be controlled by their domicile, which must be declared. No exhibit from the same household or cattery may be exhibited at any Show or Public Exhibition within 13 days prior to this Show.

CATALOGUE VOUCHERS AND EXHIBITORS PASSES WILL BE HANDED TO EXHIBITORS AT VETTING-IN

VETERINARY

Exhibits will be received at the entrance to the Show from 8.00 am to 9.30 am on the morning of the Show. All exhibits must be brought in a suitable container and must be accompanied by the owner or the owner's representative. On arrival each exhibit must be examined by the Association's Veterinary Surgeons who are authorised to exclude any exhibit they consider unfit. No exhibits may be penned before being examined.

Unfit exhibits must be removed by their owners and entry fees forfeited. If, in the opinion of the Veterinary Surgeon it is advisable, all other exhibits from the same household or cattery and the owner shall be banned from attending the Show. The Veterinary Surgeon's decision is final and the exhibit(s) shall not be re-presented to another Veterinary Surgeon. If a cat is removed to isolation following rejection by the Veterinary Surgeon after judging commenced, information regarding the Section under which the exhibit is rejected should be available to the adjacent exhibitors through the Show Manager, and the Duty Vet should explain the potential risks involved to the adjacent exhibitors.

IMPORTANT: Queens who are pregnant, lactating or who have kitted within the past 12 weeks may not be exhibited at

any Show or Exhibition and Veterinary Surgeons in attendance are instructed to reject any queen in these conditions.

Exhibits whose cats have been rejected at shows, please note the following points:

- (a) When sending your clearance certificate to the GCCF Veterinary Officer please include your copy of the rejection slip.
- (b) PLEASE DO NOT send these certificates by Recorded Delivery post as this can cause considerable delay. If you wish to satisfy yourself that your letter has reached the Veterinary Officer please enclose a stamped addressed postcard acknowledging receipt for signature and this will be returned to you.
- (c) Exhibits should not attend shows until they have received a letter accepting and confirming clearance from the Veterinary Officer. It is recommended that this letter be taken to shows within one month of issue.

VACCINATIONS REQUIRED FOR SHOW CATS: All cats exhibited at shows held under GCCF rules must have a current vaccination certificate against FIE, FVR and FCV (cat 'flu). The full course, in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, must have been completed more than seven days before the show. The certificate must have been issued by a veterinary practice/hospital and the last vaccination entry signed by a Veterinary Surgeon or by a listed Veterinary Nurse under the direction of a Veterinary Surgeon.

Cats with an invalid vaccination certificate will be rejected under Section A. Cats unaccompanied by a Vaccination Certificate will also be rejected under Section A unless the exhibitor undertakes to provide proof of vaccination, valid for that show, by sending the certificate to the GCCF Office within seven days of the show. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification from the show and the cat's name will be placed on the veterinary rejection list until proof of vaccination is received in the Office. Please note that HOMEOPATHIC VACCINATION cannot be accepted for the purpose of vetting-in.

VETERINARY LETTERS

Veterinary letters stating the origin of a lesion are not longer admissible and any exhibitor presenting a cat with skin lesions indicative of ringworm is not likely to be rejected at vetting-in. The GCCF Veterinary Officer recommends that exhibitors should not take a cat to a show if it has skin lesions.

PRESENTATION OF EXHIBITS

Take pride in presenting your exhibit and be sure it is comfortable, warm and relaxed. Every exhibit must be provided with a white sanitary tray and clean, plain white or near-white blanket or blankets without distinctive marking or edging, which may be arranged in such a manner as to assist the comfort of the cat. Cellular blankets are not allowed but white Vet-bed or like material may be used if preferred.

A hot water bottle or heat reflecting material or a cool pack may be used but must be concealed by the blanket, no other articles or decoration may be placed in or on the pen until judging has been completed. The only exception to this rule is that a container with water must be placed in the pen.

A container with food and one small toy may be placed in the pen after the time announced for the admission of the public. Food containers, if used earlier, must be removed before judging. Failure to do so may result in the disqualification of the exhibit by the show manager and in the event all fees and awards shall be forfeited.

TOXIC DISINFECTANTS, AEROSOLS AND SPRAYS ARE BANNED FROM THE SHOW HALL. SHOW EQUIPMENT, LITTER, TOYS, CAT ACCESSORIES ETC. WILL BE ON SALE IN THE SHOW HALL.

EXHIBITION & FAMOUS FELINES

These pens are designed to form a display and may be decorated in any way an exhibitor wishes. Full details of the exhibits in these Sections must be given on the official entry form, putting E1 or E2 in the Open Class box.

GENERAL GUIDELINES ON ENTERING SHOWS

Where possible always complete your show entry form from your up-to-date GCCF registration document (i.e. Registration or Transfer Certificate) for the cat that is to be exhibited. PRINTING the details carefully to avoid any misinterpretation of your handwriting. If you have not received your registration document at the time of entry, complete the show entry form with the details from the pedigree and put RAF (Registration Applied For) or TAF (Transfer Applied For) or both in the Registration No. box. It is wise to enclose a stamped addressed acknowledgement postcard with all registration and transfer applications, particularly for cats entered for shows, so that you know that the application has been received by the GCCF.

Try to keep a copy of your entry form, then when you receive registration details and number, check these against the entry form and notify the Show Manager in writing of any differences in the details as well as giving the registration number, if applicable. This may not be in time for the printing of the Show Catalogue, but the Show Manager will attach your letter to your entry form which will save unnecessary notification of discrepancies when the show is checked. All catalogue errors are checked against the original entry form and any exhibitors' letters are used for reference. Show Managements are permitted to accept corrections up to the close of the show, but such change must not be a change of exhibit.

If you are entering several cats from your household and the owners (exhibitors) differ within the family household, check with the Show Manager whether using one entry form is acceptable or not, if it is, indicate VERY CLEARLY which exhibitor owns which cat, ensuring all owners sign the entry form. It may be less confusing and more acceptable for the Show Manager for each owner to use separate entry forms but joint owners of an exhibit/exhibits should always use the same form and BOTH MUST SIGN.

STATUS OF ERRORS - WHAT TO EXPECT

Minor Errors

- (b) Disqualification by a judge on the grounds of condition must be reported by the Show Manager to the Secretary of the GCCF.
- (c) Any person whose cats have been rejected under Sections C or D must not officiate as a judge or steward or in any other capacity which requires the handling of cats at shows until a clearance certificate, as required by the GCCF, has been obtained.
- (c) Any person whose cats have been rejected under Sections C or D must not officiate as a judge or steward or in any other capacity which requires the handling of cats at shows until a clearance certificate, as required by the GCCF, has been obtained.
- (d) In addition to the classes you have entered, your cat may also be handled for the purpose of assessing candidates in the GCCF judges appointment scheme.
- (e) Photographs of exhibits may only be taken with the permission of the Show Manager and the exhibit(s) owner(s),
- (f) BLIND CATS may not be exhibited at shows licensed by the GCCF.
- (g) BITING AT SHOWS. Any cat biting or inflicting injury by deliberately scratching a judge, Veterinary Surgeon, Steward or other Show Official must be reported to the Show Manager. The Show Manager must withdraw the cat from that show and shall inform the owner of the cat in writing, sending a copy to the Secretary of the GCCF. If the cat was defending itself in exceptional and frightening circumstances, that information should be given to the Secretary of the GCCF for consideration by the Executive Committee. If the cat is reported at any subsequent show, it shall be disqualified from all future shows unless the Executive Committee rules otherwise.
- (h) No persons may steward at all for any judge under whom they or a member of their household are exhibiting in an Open, Grand or assessment class. This rule also applies to any person who is acting as an agent for the owner of a cat entered in a relevant class. This shall also include cats not entered in the Open but to be considered for Best of Breed.

The Show Management reserves the right to:

- (a) Publish an announcement in 'Our Cats' of any alteration in the Schedule or in the Show Rules and Regulations and this shall be deemed sufficient notice.
- (b) Retain a percentage of the Entry Fees to cover essential expenses in the event of the Show Being cancelled for any reason.
- (c) Reserves the right to pass on any charges incurred by an Exhibitor whose cheque(s) are refused by the Association's bankers.

COUNTERSIGNING OF CERTIFICATES

In the event of a change of judge of an Open Class occurring after the closing date of the show, providing the exhibitor informs the Show Manager prior to judging that a Certificate has previously been awarded by the replacement judge, the Show Manager shall appoint one other judge who shall judge the cat, and if the cat is considered worthy, countersign the Certificate which shall then count towards Championship status.

If the replacement judge at the first show has also previously been booked for the subsequent show, the closing date of which is before the date of the first show, then at the subsequent show this judge can be regarded as a replacement judge for the purpose of requesting a countersignature.

When a cat which has been awarded a certificate at the Supreme Show is entered under the same judge, for the equivalent certificate, during the following three months, then at one subsequent show this judge can be regarded as a replacement for the purpose of requesting a countersignature.

WITHDRAWAL OF EXHIBITS FROM CAT SHOWS

The last date for withdrawal of a cat is the advertised closing date for entries at that show. After this date the cat concerned may not be withdrawn from the catalogue of the show and the 13 day rule about entering two shows within 13 days will apply. There will be no refund of entry fees after the published closing date or if the cat is not present at the show. This ruling does not prevent the Show Manager from returning entries after the closing date of the show if they are unable to accept them in the show because the show is full. ALL WITHDRAWALS MUST BE IN WRITING.

CORRESPONDENCE

All correspondence must be accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope. Any complaints relating to the show must be forwarded to the Show Manager within seven (7) days of the show.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Open Classes: Open to all of the specified breed.

Cats: Not less than 9 calendar months on the day of the show.

Kittens: Entire and Neutered Kittens not less than 14 weeks and under 9 calendar months on the day of the show. i.e. born on or before the 28th January 2006.
Neuter Kittens will be entered in Kitten and Miscellaneous Classes and will compete for BIS Kitten.
Exhibitors must inform the Show Manager if a kitten is entered as entire but neutered before the show day.

Neuters: Neutered cats, male or female, must be registered. Neuters may only enter Neuter Classes and may not compete with entire cats or kittens except in Club Classes which are scheduled to include Neuters. Where Best in Show is held, the Best Neuter shall be considered against the Best Adult and Kitten for

Best Exhibit in Show.

- Débutante: Exhibits that have never been shown at a show held under GCCF Rules.
- Novice: Exhibits that have not won a First Prize in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
- Limit: Exhibits that have not won more than four first Prizes in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
- Maiden: Exhibits that have not won a First, Second or Third Prize in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
- Breeders: Exhibits bred by exhibitor(s). Cats originally registered in the Breeders joint ownership but changed to single ownership of one of the Breeders can still be entered in this class. Cats originally registered in the Breeder's single ownership and changed to joint ownership with the Breeder should be entered in the Non-Breeders Class.
- Aristocrat: Exhibits that have been awarded Certificates but are not Premiers or Champions on the closing date of this show.
- Adolescent: Exhibits aged between 9 calendar months and 15 calendar months on the day of the show.
- Junior: Exhibits aged between 9 calendar months and 2 years on the day of the show.
- Senior: Cats between 2 years and 7 years old on the day of the Show.
- Veteran: aged 7 years or more on the day of the show.
- Radius: Exhibits living within the Counties of Gloucester, Hereford & Worcester, Leicester, Northampton, Oxford, Shropshire, Warwick and West Midlands.
- Visitor: Exhibits living outside the Radius Counties.

The status of the exhibit entering restricted classes (I.e. Novice, Limit etc.) shall be the status on the day of entry. If an exhibit has attained the status of Champion or Premier, as the case may be, on or before the closing date for entries as published in this Schedule, it shall be eligible to enter the Grand Champion or Grand Premier Class and, if entering the Imperial Grand Champion/Premier class, as the case may be the exhibit may also be entered in **either** the Grand Champion/Premier class **or** the Open Breed class.

Wins as kittens to not count when the exhibit is shown as an Adult or Neuter. Wins as an Adult do not count when shown as a Neuter.

BLOCK ENTRY FEES

Block entry includes Benching, Open Class and three other Classes.
Maximum number of classes must not exceed ten.

One **free pass** per entry form.

Extra passes may be purchased with your entry @ £1.50 for adults
and £1.00 for Children under 16 and Senior Citizens.
